Things to Do and See - Leisure Inn Plaza Hotel, Townsville

Museum Of Tropical Queensland	The Museum of Tropical Queensland is a world-class museum, bursting with fun, fascinating and interactive displays. With a primary focus on North Queensland, it reveals the secrets of life in the tropics, the region's unique fauna and flora, and weird and wonderful creatures from the deep sea and Australia's past.
Riverway	Located in Thuringowa on the magnificent Ross River frontage, Riverway is fast becoming one of the most exciting destinations Townsville has to offer. With two huge swimming lagoons, the Riverway Arts Centre, Pinnacles Gallery, the Riverwalk, public art, village spine, restaurant, and parklands, there truly is so much to explore.
Cotters Market	Cotters Market is North Queensland's award winning arts and crafts market held every Sunday between 8.30 am and 1.00 pm in Flinders Mall Townsville. Cotters Market is a great place to shop. They have ultra-fresh fruit and vegetables, stunning jewellery, original art works, massages, woodwork, stuffed toads, home-baked cakes, gifts for all occasions and entertainment.
Castle Hill	Castle Hill is a red rock monolith in the heart of Townsville offering panoramic views, and a slice of military history. There is a popular walking track for the fitness focused and a road offers access for vehicles and pedestrians. The hill is just metres short of being classified as a mountain. Take a drive to the rock and learn about its' interesting history!
Reef HQ Aquarium	Reef HQ is the world's largest living coral reef aquarium and national reef education centre for the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park. It is the only coral reef aquarium on the Queensland coast for visitors to experience the reef from a fish-eye-view. Reef HQ is your opportunity to visit the Great Barrier Reef without getting wet, sunburnt or seasick.
Red Baron Seaplanes	Red Baron Seaplanes and their signature aircraft The Red Baron, offer flights over beautiful Magnetic Island & Townsville. The historical Grumman Sea-Cat is the only two passenger, open cockpit bi-plane on floats in the world. Fly in the Red Baron for an experience of a lifetime.
Adventure Activities	Come find your perfect combination of adrenalin-pumping and recreational activities in Townsville. Whether your idea of adventure is kayaking on the open sea, sky diving, white water rafting or simply a horse back ride along the beach. There is something for everyone in Townsville. Ask at Reception for local tours that will give you the adventure you need!
The Civic Club	Drop into the Civic Club, originally known as the Londoner's Club, (a gentlemen's club) and enjoy a drink with the locals, soak up the atmosphere of this amazing historic building and have a round of billiards on one of the two 100 year old tables. Don't forget to make your booking for their famous Friday night barbecue. Located in Ryan Street just a 5 minute drive or leisurely stroll from the hotel.
Maritime Museum	Located a short stroll from the hotel on the banks of the Ross Creek the Maritime Museum of Townsville is best known for its display about the doomed ship SS Yongala, sunk south of Townsville in 1911. Other fascinating exhibits include The Women's War Two display, information about the Royal Australian Navy and the history of Townsville and its port. A model boat building room, boat shed, small research library and barbecue area can also be found here.
Dining	Dining is a serious business in Townsville. Take a wander down Palmer Street and find restaurants offering cuisines from around the world, prepared using the freshest local seafood and produce. Or enjoy a delicious meal at Stanley's Restaurant and Bar located on the first floor of Leisure Inn Plaza Hotel! Or have a drink at the Grandstand Bar.
