Things to Do and See - Leisure Inn Pokolbin Hill, Hunter Valley

Vineyards & wineries	The Hunter Valley is now recognised as the birthplace of the multi-billion dollar-a-year wine making industry. The Hunter is renowned for its full-bodied white wines, 'medium weight reds' and some excellent ports. Some of the vineyards belong to big name companies such as Lindemans, others, like Tyrells and Draytons which have been there for several generations and remained independent. The range of wines in the Hunter Valley is endless.
Bluetongue Brewery Cafe	Quality wine and boutique beer are most compatible and what better way to finish a hard day of tasting in the Hunter Valley Wine Country than with a cleansing beer. Try the unique Beer Tasting Paddle, laze away the afternoon listening to great music, enjoy a quick game of pool, or something delicious off the blackboard menu.
Hunter Valley Gardens	Spanning over 60 acres, be amazed by the sensational sights, colours, and fragrances of the ten stunning feature gardens. Explore each garden one-by-one and enjoy an exciting journey through the thousands of flowers, trees, and shrubs with an air of discovery at every turn. Along the eight kilometres of walking paths are more than six thousand trees, one million ground covers and six hundred thousand shrubs.
Lavender Gate Farm	Experience a 'touch of Provence' as you stroll through fragrant rows of lavender. The Gate Café & Gallery with its rustic provincial charm is the ideal place to stop and recharge as you tour the vineyards. Just 4 minutes from historic Wollombi village, the gateway to Wine Country. You will enjoy the scent of Lavender Gate Farm long after you leave.

Bush Walking	Hunter Valley is surrounded by a number of National Parks that make for excellent bushwalking. The Watagans National Park covers 7,751 hectares of an extensive mountain range and Werakata National Park has a rich history of Aboriginal occupation. It is the most easily accessible park in the area and can be reached within 5 minutes from the Visitor Information Centre.
