Things to Do and See - Leisure Inn Spires, Blue Mountains

Scenic World	Scenic World offers a range of experiences found nowhere else on Earth. The Skyway takes you on a 720 metre journey, 270m above ancient ravines and dazzling waterfalls. You are suspended over Jurassic rainforests as you glide smoothly across the sky. The Scenic Cableway takes you on a 545 metre ride into - or out of - the World Heritage-listed rainforest of the Jamison Valley.
MORE at Scenic World	The Scenic Railway takes you on a 415m descent through a cliff side tunnel down into an ancient rainforest. Scenic Walkway - discover over 2.8kms of boardwalk through the ancient rainforest. Scenic Cinema - the cinema offers a fascinating Blue Mountains documentary - shown any time on demand.
Mount Annan Botanic Garden	Mount Annan Botanic Garden is the Australian native plant garden of the Royal Botanic Gardens, Sydney. It covers 410 hectares, making it the largest botanic garden in Australia and the most visited tourism attraction in the Macarthur area.
Aboriginal Walkabout Tour	Inspiring and adventurous, this amazing Australian Aboriginal walkabout will provide you with ancient wisdom to enrich your life and a deep connection and understanding of country and culture! Walk begins in the Blue Mountains on Faulconbridge Railway Station platform meeting at 10.00 am. Ask at Reception for tour details.
Explorer Bus	The Blue Mountains Explorer Bus allows you the flexibility to plan your day according to your interests. Operating on a regular basis from Katoomba Railway Station, with thirty minute frequencies throughout most of the day, the full day pass has no restrictions. Hop on and hop off as you please. This means you can plan your day around the all the major attractions on offer in the region. Hop on Hop Off at 29 Stops. Buy your ticket at Reception.
Leura Mall	Stroll down to Leura Mall, with its crisp mountain air and scenic natural beauty it contains a variety of specialty gourmet shops, gift shops, coffee houses and restaurants. Leura's streets are tree-lined and elegant. Major attractions in the area include Leurella, Everglades Gardens and Gordon Falls Reserve.
Natural Wonders	The Blue Mountains region has some of the most breathtaking landscapes in the country. At Katoomba, the Three Sisters gaze out to the imposing presence of Mount Solitary. Mountain streams flow through beautiful river gorges or tumble over the escarpment in stunning waterfall displays. Ask at Reception for directions to these natural wonders!
Zig Zag Railway	It is a magical step back in time, filled with sights, sounds and smells of a bygone era. Every trip from Clarence Station winds its way through the remarkable Blue Mountains' scenery, offering glimpses of grand sandstone viaducts, accompanied by the chuffing steam locomotive. Trains run daily (except Christmas Day) at 11am, 1pm, 3pm from Clarence Station.
Norman Lindsay Gallery	The Norman Lindsay Gallery at Faulconbridge is the home of the Magic Pudding and displays the work of artist and writer Norman Lindsay (1879-1969). Run by the National Trust, the sandstone cottage and landscaped grounds are open 7 days a week and there is a specialist gift shop and cafe. Lindsay's Café offers a popular and distinctly unique dining experience.
Jenolan Caves	Regarded as Australia's most outstanding cave system - with 11 spectacular show caves, pure underground rivers and amazing formations - Jenolan Caves is among the finest and oldest cave systems in the world. Visit this 'hidden gem', for fascinating cave tours and other activities, to suit every age and fitness level.
