## Things to Do and See - Park Regis City Centre, Sydney CBD

| Beaches                   | Sydney is renowned for its beautiful beaches such as famous Bondi, Bronte and Tamarama. In addition to the waves, you can visit the Bondi Markets every Sunday. Bus 380 from Circular Quay will get you there in about 40 minutes or the train to Bondi Junction, then buses 381 or 382 will drop you off right on the beach as well. The bus from Bondi Junction to the beach takes about 15 minutes.           |
| Hop On Hop Off Bus Tour   | Explore Sydney and Bondi with this 24 or 48 hour ticket aboard an open-top double-decker bus. See all the main sights as you hop on and hop off 30 conveniently located stops around the city. A hop-on hop-off tour of Sydney truly is the best way to see the sights of Sydney and Bondi. Hop on at the Queen Victoria Building and purchase your ticket onboard.  |
| Sydney Opera House        | The Sydney Opera House, situated on Sydney Harbour at Bennelong Point, is considered by many to be one of the wonders of the modern world. Choose from a one or two hour tour that take in the extraordinary history, breathtaking architecture and the unseen workings of the Opera House and its daily life or take you behind-the-scenes to stand on stage in the world-famous Concert Hall or Opera Theatre. |
| Taronga Zoo               | A 12 minute ferry ride from Circular Quay will take you to Taronga Zoo. Ferries depart from Circular Quay every quarter past and quarter to the hour. At the zoo you can see the new pygmy hippopotamus, cheetah cubs, and the rare Tasmanian Devil. The zoo also has daily presentations, animal encounters, and guided tours available.  |
| Sightseeing Tours         | Sydney has some of the most spectacular scenery and built heritage of any cosmopolitan city in the world. The natural beauty and diversity of Sydney's National Parks, including the Hawkesbury and the Blue Mountains is a must for nature lovers. For more information ask at Reception for tour ideas or to make a booking at the Blue Mountains or Hunter Valley.  |
| Darling Harbour           | Spend a day at Darling Harbour. There's always plenty happening, lots to see and do, great shopping and over 50 places to eat and drink, take a walk over the Harbour Bridge, visit the Aquarium or have a meal at Cockle Bay. Darling Harbour is host to over 700 events of some description in an average year.  |
| Sydney Shopping           | For all your shopping needs in the one place, check out the Pitt Street Mall, walk George Street from the CBD to Chinatown and explore countless shops - Paddy's Markets is a must. Some of the best shopping areas in Sydney including the Queen Victoria Building and the Strand Arcade  |
| Galleries & Museums       | Sydney is home to some of Australia's best museums and galleries. Access to some of them is free, however, you generally have to pay a small fee to see special exhibitions. For more information ask at Reception. Most major museums and galleries are only a short walk from the hotel.   |
| The Royal Botanic Gardens | The Royal Botanic Gardens were first established in 1816 and they are now one of Sydney's finest natural assets. The gardens also offer some of the best views of Sydney Harbour. From Circular Quay, the gardens are an easy 10 minute walk just past the Opera House.  |
| Sydney Nightlife          | Go for a casual or formal dinner, visit a bar or club or simply take in the sights. There is so much to do in Sydney city and you are located right in the midst of the action! Kings Cross is a short walk up the road. Or you can catch a bus, train or taxi.  |
