Things to Do and See - Park Regis City Quays, Cairns

Great Barrier Reef	A trip to Cairns is not complete without a trip to the reef. Nowhere else can you better experience the natural wonders of the planet's largest marine park than in Cairns. Cairns is Australia's closest and easiest access point to the Great Barrier Reef, where diving, snorkelling, sailing, cruising and island hopping are a way of life. Ask at Reception for the tour that would most suit you!
Shopping	Whether it's a big shopping centre you are after or you prefer to stroll through heritage markets - shopping in Cairns is a must. From hand-made artefacts to simple groceries and needs you are sure to find somewhere that has what you're looking for. Cairns Central Shopping Centre is located a short walk from the hotel, is open seven days and has over 180 specialty stores.
Skyrail	Skyrail Rainforest Cableway is a unique rainforest experience taking you on an unforgettable journey over Australia's World Heritage protected Tropical Rainforests. Spanning seven and a half kilometres, Skyrail has comfortable six-person gondola cabins which glide just metres above the canopy, providing spectacular and uninterrupted views of the rainforest, tropical Cairns, the Coral Sea and the lush Cairns Highlands.
Kuranda Scenic Railway	A spectacular journey comprising unsurpassed views of dense rainforest, steep ravines and picturesque waterfalls. Rising from sea level to 328 metres, the journey takes approximately one hour and 45 minutes from Cairns to Kuranda and passes through World Heritage protected tropical rainforest, past beautiful and spectacular waterfalls and into the awesome Barron Gorge.
Tjapukai Aboriginal Cultural Park	Showcases the "People of the Rainforest's" indigenous culture, allowing you to watch theatrical performances and engage in interactive activities to learn the traditional culture and customs of the Tjapukai people. Your cultural experience includes face painting on arrival, Creation and History Theatre presentations, cultural performance, Bush foods and Medicine show, Didgeridoo demonstration and more!
The Reef Casino	Experience the excitement and fun of Australia's finest boutique casino, only a short stroll from the hotel. The Reef Casino offers all the excitement expected from an internationally operated casino. Play games such as blackjack, baccarat, paradise pontoon, roulette, money wheel, and slots. Will you be lucky?
Cairns Night Markets	Located on The Esplanade, Cairns Night Markets provide a great opportunity for after hours shopping. More than 70 stalls converge here to provide a selection of homewares, giftwares, tattoos, crocodile skins and pearls. The market is indoors, with the comfort of air-conditioning, but captures all the atmosphere of an outdoor market.
The Esplanade	Although Cairns doesn't have a beach, it boasts a beautiful Esplanade. Swim in a saltwater lagoon surrounded by grassy picnic areas and walking tracks. Facilities also include an outdoor amphitheatre, children's playground, barbecue, restaurants, shops, an environmental interpretation centre, and a Great Barrier Reef cruise departure terminal.
Adventure Tours/Activities	Raging Thunder Adventures pioneered rafting in Queensland in 1984. They have a product range to include a series of adventure tours suitable for all levels of excitement including white water rafting, heli-rafting, sea kayaking, hot air ballooning, trekking, sky diving, and four wheel drive tours. They have tour packages for groups or for the independent traveller.
Food Trail Tours	Enjoy the taste of the tropics as delectable tropical cuisine beckons as an outstanding attraction in itself, whether served at one of the many award winning restaurants or as part of a gourmet tour. On tour with Food Trail Tours, you explore the sights of the Cairns Highlands, Atherton Tablelands as well as visiting local food and tropical fruit wine producers.
